**Cycle of Prayer:** During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression & the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for Fr Colum, the sick & housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's & St Joseph's schools, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

**Corpus Christi Church:** This Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June, Bishop Patrick will be visiting our parish as we celebrate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Dedication of the Church. Mass will be celebrated in Corpus Christi Church at 7.00 pm and will be followed by a shared table in Holy Trinity Parish Hall. All are welcome to Mass – and please bring something for the shared table, which should be taken into Holy Trinity Parish Hall before Mass. Fr Andrew

**Diocesan Restructuring:** As part of an ongoing restructuring of the Diocese of Nottingham, Lindsey Deanery, which includes our parish, and Lincoln Deanery will be merged, and a new dean appointed by Bishop Patrick. Many parishes in the new deanery will move towards merger, which will better enable the celebration of the sacred liturgy, catechesis, and pastoral care and administration; for example, the two parishes in Scunthorpe and the parishes of Crowle and Gainsborough will eventually be merged, and Lincoln's three parishes will be merged into one parish served by two priests instead of the current four. This year, eight parish priests will be retiring, and there are no Ordinations to the priesthood planned for a few years; much of what we have done in our parish to prepare, for many years, and implement is now having to be done across the Diocese. Please pray for all those who will be affected, as we were and are. Fr Andrew
