CAFOD: The scenes from last week's devastating earthquake in Syria and Turkey have shocked us all. The Disasters Emergency Committee has launched an appeal across the United Kingdom to provide aid to families and communities which have been torn apart – people have been left without warmth or shelter in freezing conditions, and access to clean water is a real challenge. At least 40,000 people have died, many thousands have been injured and seventeen million people live in the affected area, many of them in urgent need of food, shelter and medical care. We will have a retiring collection this weekend to support CAFOD's humanitarian relief efforts in Syria and Turkey. Eucharistic Adoration: This Lent, once again, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament before our three celebrations of Sunday Mass, beginning half an hour before Mass and concluding with Benediction a few minutes before Mass, and also each Wednesday at 6.15 pm and Saturdays usually at 10.00 am. The Church teaches that prayer before Christ the Lord sacramentally present in the Blessed Eucharist 'renews the covenant which in turn moves them to maintain in their lives what they have received by faith and by sacraments. They should try to lead their whole lives with the strength derived from the heavenly food, as they share in the death and resurrection of the Lord. Everyone should be concerned with good deeds and with pleasing God so that they may imbue the world with the Christian spirit and be a witness of Christ in the midst of human society.'
