All are welcome to our breakfasts and lunches, and the Lenten Alms baskets are in our churches next to the Altar.

Holy Communion: Please take time this Lent to read *The Eucharist*, which was distributed last Sunday; further copies are available in each church and from the parish office. In his pastoral letter, Bishop Patrick said that the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds, the Sacred Host and the Precious Blood, a common practice in our diocese before the first lockdown, can recommence on Maundy Thursday. I will consult everyone next Sunday so that we can discern what will be right for us to do here in our parish. In the meantime, please email me if you have any specific comments, and let us pray together that our celebration of Sunday Mass and reception of Holy Communion will continue to be at the heart of our lives.
