I am hoping that we will have people to set up at least two teams so that the church can be cleaned regularly, beginning before Easter, and I am grateful to all those who work so hard to look after our three churches. **Easter Liturgies:** Please take one of the cards listing the principal celebrations of the Sacred Paschal Triduum and the four celebrations of Mass on Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord to keep yourself – and at least one other to give to a relative, friend or neighbour whom you will be inviting to join you at Mass. The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night will begin around the fire outside St Mary on the Sea Church at 8.00 pm on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> April, and is the fulcrum of the Church's year, and Mass will be celebrated in each of our three parish churches on Easter Sunday morning, at 8.00 am in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church, 9.30 am in Corpus Christi Church and 11.00 am in St Mary on the Sea Church. I hope that as many people as possible will gather from across our parish to celebrate the Easter Vigil, and also the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday at 7.00 pm in Corpus Christi Church and the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday at 3.00 pm as we journey with Jesus through his Passion, Death and Resurrection.

**The Faithful Departed:** Please pray for: Mary Angela Linfitt, whose Funeral Mass will be celebrated in Corpus Christi Church on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> March at 1.00 pm prior to Committal in Cleethorpes Cemetery; and for all who mourn their loss.

**'Raised Up to A New Hope' – 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2023:** To prepare ourselves to celebrate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus, we will have our **Liturgy of Reconciliation** in Corpus Christi Church, this Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> March, at 7.00 pm; there will be visiting priests to hear confessions, and the liturgy will be followed by tea and coffee in Holy Trinity Parish Hall.

**The Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick** can be received at any time and should be received by those who are ill – whatever the illness, whether it is chronic or acute, mental or physical – or who are preparing for serious surgery. To arrange for me to visit you:

- If you or a relative are in the Diana Princess of Wales Hospital, please ask a nurse to ask switchboard to contact the chaplaincy and ask for me to visit. If you contact St Mary's Presbytery directly, please have the patient's consent to do so, and provide us with their date of birth and/or address, and which ward they are on; contact for a patient in A&E should always be via the nurse.
- If you or a relative are in other care settings, such as St Andrew's Hospice or a nursing or residential home, please ask a member of staff to contact the parish office (01472 342301; office@holytrinitygci.uk).
- if you or a relative are at home, please contact the parish office (01472 342301; office@holytrinitygci.uk).

In case of serious illness, please do not wait until someone's death is imminent before contacting me lest I be simply unable to visit them in time; similarly, please do not wait until someone is feeling better! It is never too early to receive the sacraments, which are God's gracious help for us in the circumstances in which we find ourselves so we should avail ourselves of them. Fr Andrew
