Fire Safety: During Mass, **only stewards may sit in the porch** — everyone else must be in the main body of the church or outside, and the only people who should be in the porches are the stewards who are on duty, those entering or leaving the churches, and those who are in a queue for the loo. standing in the porches will be asked by the stewards — or, if that doesn't work, by me! — to move into the main body of the church in order that they may celebrate Mass worthily, attentively and devoutly, and to ensure everyone's safety especially if there is a need to evacuate the church in an emergency. Holy Communion: In addition to the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday and the Easter Vigil during the Holy Night on Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord, we will also have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion under both kinds on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (Trinity Sunday, our parish patronal festival), the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) and when we celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism, the Sacrament of Confirmation, including this Friday, 26th May, and First Holy Communion, including this Sunday at 11.00 am Mass in St Mary on the Sea Church and at the 9.00 am & 11.00 am Masses on Sunday 18th June & Sunday 25th June.

Holy Hour — 11th June 2023: To celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, there will be Holy Hour in Corpus Christi Church on Sunday 11th June at 3.00 pm, to which all are welcome; Holy Hour will be followed by light refreshments in Holy Trinity Parish Hall.

World Communications Day — 21st May 2023: The Holy Father asks us to listen before speaking with the heart, which radically challenges the times in which we are living, which are so inclined towards indifference and indignation, at times even on the basis of disinformation which falsifies and exploits the truth.' This weekend, there will be a second collection to support the work of the Catholic Communications Network, which assists the Bishops of England and Wales in explaining the Catholic faith and representing the Church in the media.
