**Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**, Trinity Sunday, the patronal feast of our parish, and we rejoice today and every day in our dedication to the Most Holy and Undivided Trinity, Almighty God in Godself, 'one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance,' the divine mystery who lives at the very heart of our faith. In the imperfection and inadequacies of human language and imagery, we express our understanding and experience of God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We have been chosen by the Lord as the People of God, and in Baptism are called to be who we truly are, valuing all in the name of Jesus the Christ by exercising our baptismal mission as Prophet, Priest and King so that all may flourish. This is symbolised in our parish's logo, the shape of which represents the Persons of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, in their unity, equality and diversity, their goodness, truth and beauty, and the colours represent the People of God, us, in our unity, equality and diversity, our goodness, truth and beauty.

I have said on many occasions that it has been the greatest privilege of my life to be your parish priest, and I take pride in the rich diversity of our wonderful parish. The opposite of unity is disunity, not diversity. We are a family, and as with our other families we experience the joys and hopes, the griefs and sorrows of journeying together in the light of Christ; I am sorry for my own mistakes and weaknesses, and I would like to thank everyone who ministers alongside me and those who support me behind the scenes.

Just as the Three Persons of the Most Holy Trinity live in a holy communion of personal, communal, relational and equal love, we are called to live in a holy communion of personal, communal, relational and equal love, loving generously and outrageously, radically and extravagantly, with that same all-embracing and all-inclusive love which is God in Godself. May we always love one another with the same love with which God always and can only ever love us.

Let us ask the Father through the Son in the Holy Spirit to bless our parish, our schools, our families and all whom we are called to serve in our daily lives as we journey together in Christ, whose Body we are. Fr Andrew

**Contactless Giving:** Those who wish are now able to give their offertory collection and other collections using contactless giving in each of our three churches:

- Select the option you wish to donate/provide funds for.
- Select an amount you would like to donate from the options on screen or another amount from £1 upwards.
- Present your card or phone (contactless) or insert your card (chip and pin) to the payment device.
- If you are giving to the offertory collection or another collection, you will then be asked if you would like to gift aid your donation – you can gift aid offertory collection but cannot gift aid payments to the repository; please answer yes or no.
- If you answer yes, you will be required to enter your house number, postcode (in block capitals) and email – this will only happen the first time you use the machine, and whenever you use the machines in our churches again, you will not have to register for gift aid again, as you will be remembered on the system; it will then take your payment.
- If you answer no, the machine will take your payment.

We should all contribute what we can to support our parish, our Diocese of Nottingham and the Universal Church, as well as the various charities which we support, and I am grateful to everyone who is so generous in supporting the Church's mission financially. Fr Andrew
