Prayer to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: O Jesus, open wide thy heart! Mass Intentions: Requesting for Mass to be offered for a specific intention is a beautiful way of asking our parish family to pray for that intention and, by giving an offering, you support the mission of the Church in our parish. Please give at least six months' notice if you wish Mass to be offered for a specific intention on a specific day in a specific church; if it is not possible to offer the Mass on the requested date, e.g., if

there is no Mass that day or there is already an intention, it will be offered as soon as is practicable, as it will if you do not have a specific date in mind. One Mass every Sunday and holyday of obligation is offered for all the people of our parish (Missa pro populo), something which every diocesan Bishop and parish priest is obliged to do for those entrusted to their pastoral care. Mass intentions are published in the Sunday Message and announced during the prayer of the faithful. The suggested minimum Mass offering in our diocese is £10.00. Please place your offering in one of the brown envelopes, which can then be left in the offertory collection boxes.
