Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for June, the Month of the Sacred Heart:

Baptism is the foundation of the Christian life: we are born again as children of God, clothed with Christ and consecrated to share in his threefold Mission as Prophet, Priest and King. Deacon Stephen will lead the next preparation course in Holy Trinity Parish Hall on Thursday 14th September at 7.00 pm. Parishioners who would like their children to be baptised, either in this parish or elsewhere, should complete the form which is available at the back of each church and return it to Fr Andrew at Sunday Mass; this should be done in good time and can be done before the child is born. Once the course has been completed, a date and time will be set for the Baptism; Baptism can only be celebrated in our parish, or permission given for the Baptism to be celebrated in another parish, whether in this country or abroad, once the course has been attended so that parents understand what it means to promise to bring their children up in the practice of the faith.

Parish Survey – 2nd July 2023: On the Solemnity of Pentecost, I read Bishop Patrick's pastoral letter, in which he talked how our Diocese of Nottingham, which will celebrate its 175th anniversary, is developing a plan to enable our parishes, schools and chaplaincies to be better supported in their mission, whilst also striving to ensure that our priests, of whom we have fewer, are best able to serve our parishes. To determine how to achieve these goals best, the Bishop needs a strategy that is well-informed by a wide audience, and so the Bishop has asked me to conduct a survey of our whole parish family on a few key elements. Other priests have been asked as well. This survey will take place at each Mass next weekend, and the responses will be forwarded to the Diocese; our feedback will be most helpful in shaping the Bishop's plans for the future of the Diocese of Nottingham.
