Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for July, the Month of the Precious Blood: We pray that Catholics may place the celebration of the Eucharist at the heart of their lives, transforming human relationships in a very deep way and opening to the encounter with God and all their brothers and sisters.

Cycle of Prayer: During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression and the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

'The Eucharistic Celebration is an encounter with the risen Jesus and, at the same time, a way of opening ourselves to the world as he taught us. Each time we participate in the Eucharist, Jesus comes, and Jesus gives us the strength to love like he loved, because it gives us the courage to encounter others, to go out of ourselves, and to open ourselves to others with love.

'Let us pray that Catholics place at the centre of their lives the Eucharistic Celebration, which profoundly transforms human relationships and opens up an encounter with God and their brothers and sisters.'
