Liturgical Ministries: I am grateful to everyone who ministers as MCs, Altar servers, readers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, musicians and stewards, as well as all who assist behind the scenes as florists, sacristans and cleaners – thank you to one and all. We are always looking for more ministers so that everyone can play their part and so that it spreads the workload for those who give of their time and effort so generously:

- If you were an **extraordinary minister of Holy Communion** before lockdown and would like to recommence your ministry, speak to Fr Andrew.
