Evangelii Gaudium Sunday – 17th September 2023: Today is Evangelii Gaudium Sunday, named after Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation on the Joy of the Gospel; it offers the Catholic Church in England and Wales the opportunity to celebrate the beauty of our faith and our commitment to witness to the fullness of life in Christ, and there will be a second collection today to support the Church's evangelising mission here in England and Wales.
