Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for September, the Month of the Seven Sorrows of Mary: We pray that those living on the margins of society, in inhumane life conditions, may not be overlooked by institutions and never considered of lesser importance.

Cycle of Prayer: During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Annual Parish Meeting – 5th October 2023: Our annual parish meeting will begin with the celebration of Mass in Corpus Christi Church at 6.00 pm on Thursday 5th October, and after Mass will continue in Holy Trinity Parish Hall with tea and coffee, and a reflection on where we are as a parish and where we are heading in accordance with our Vision.

Blessing of Animals – 7th October 2023: St Francis of Assisi is the patron saint of animals, and so this year, on the Saturday nearest his Memorial on 4th October, we will have a blessing of animals at St Mary on the Sea Church at 9.00 am, to which all animals, big and small, and their owners/chiefs-of-staff, big and small, are welcome! Holy Hour – 1st October 2023: To begin the month dedicated to the Rosary, we will have Holy Hour with the recitation of the Joyful Mysteries, using prayers prepared by CAFOD for the Season of Creation, in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church on Sunday 1st October at 3.00 pm; after Benediction, Fr Andrew will bless a bench which has been made in our parish in memory of Fr Murray, Fr James and Fr Tony. All are welcome!

Journey in Faith – 11th October 2023: Anyone who is interested in becoming a Catholic, or anyone, Catholic or non-Catholic, who wishes to learn more about the Catholic Faith, is welcome to gather in St Mary's Presbytery on Wednesday 11th October after 7.00 pm Mass.

The Mass is the source and summit of our lives as individuals, as a parish, as the Diocese and as the Universal Church. The **obligation to celebrate Mass** on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation is rooted in the Third Commandment, to keep the

Lord's Day holy with worship and rest. The obligation cannot be fulfilled by celebrating Mass online; the livestream is primarily for those who are excused the obligation, e.g., because of sickness. To help us learn more about the Mass, for six Saturdays in Holy Trinity Parish Hall, beginning on Saturday 7th October, Deacon Stephen will be journeying through the Mass as Bishop Robert Barron explains the different elements of it in an informative and engaging way. At the end of the six weeks, he guarantees that you will see the Mass in all its glory and majesty; so much that you will ask yourself, 'How can anyone choose to miss it?' Each session will begin at 10.00 am with tea, coffee and soft drinks in Holy Trinity Parish Hall, and will conclude with Holy Hour at noon.

Ministries Fayre – 30th September 2023: Our parish is a large and diverse parish in which everyone is welcome, and all are equal. In addition to the various liturgical ministries, our Baptism gives us the impetus to serve Christ in our sisters and brothers, in social justice, and the Earth, in environmental justice in accordance with our parish's Vision.
