A Prayer for the Synod: 'We stand before you, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in your name. Let us find in you our unity, so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of you, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, for ever and ever. Amen.' Our Holy Father Pope Francis will close this session of the Sixteenth Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops during Mass today in Saint Peter's Basilica; the next session will be in Rome next year. Meanwhile, we are all called to pray for the Synodal Process, which provides an opportunity for the entire People of God to discern together how to move forward, in communion, participation and mission, at a worldwide, diocesan and a parochial level. We must continue to ask ourselves: how does this journeying together allow the Church to proclaim the Gospel in accordance with the mission entrusted to her by Christ, and what steps does the Spirit invite us to take to grow as a synodal Church?
