**Evening Mass Times:** Since I became parish priest in January 2017, I have ensured that there is at least one weekday evening Mass each week to enable those who work to celebrate Mass. It has been suggested to me that weekday evening Masses should be at 6.00 pm rather than 7.00 pm, to make attendance easier for those who work, as they would be able to go to church on their way home rather than go home and then come back out again, and so that everyone could get home earlier to enjoy the rest of their evening. Please let me know this week if you have any strong feelings about this, particularly if you currently attend a weekday evening Mass, or if you think you would consider attending with an earlier Mass time, and if there is a consensus that we should trial Mass at 6.00 pm, we will do so beginning in the first week of Advent, and review it in February. - Caroline Leighton will lead a **half-day of recollection**, looking at the meaning of the four weeks of Advent, on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, beginning with tea and coffee in Holy Trinity Parish Hall at 10.00 am and concluding with Holy Hour in Corpus Christi Church at noon.
- There will be **Holy Hour** on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December at 3.00 pm in St Mary on the Sea Church, followed by light refreshments in St Mary's Presbytery, to pray for our parish as we begin our new liturgical year.
- To ready ourselves to celebrate Our Lord's Birth at Christmas with a clear conscience, there will be a **Liturgy of Reconciliation** in Corpus Christi Church, with visiting priests to hear confessions in English and Polish, on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December at 7.00 pm; the liturgy will be followed by light refreshments in Holy Trinity Parish Hall.
