Christ is Our Joy: God of all, John the Baptist came to bear witness to your light. Fill us with faith and the courage to act upon it, so that we may shine a light in the darkness and share the love we have found in you. Amen.

'You want to put the "Christ" back in Christmas? Feed the hungry, comfort the afflicted, love the outcast, forgive the wrongdoer, inspire the hopeless.' How will our light shine before others this Christmas?

Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for December, the Month of the Divine Infancy: We pray that people living with disabilities may be at the centre of attention in society, and that institutions may offer inclusive programs which value their active participation.

Cycle of Prayer: During the Seasons of Advent and Christmas, we pray for: openness to the Word of God; migrants and refugees; and expectant mothers. We also pray for the sick and housebound, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Christmas Cribs have been placed in our three churches and will remain before us until the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, Friday 2nd February 2023, so we have plenty of time to pray before them! This year, our crib offerings will support the Friends of the Holy Land, which helps Christians in Our Lord's earthly homeland, and which will support relief in Gaza, where so many people have been killed and others whose lives are at risk during what is supposed to the season of goodwill to all. Thank you to everyone who has decorated our churches so beautifully with Cribs, trees and flowers, and please be generous to this charity. Mary and Joseph will continue to journey with us as we prepare for Christmas!

Christmas Masses: Please take one of the cards listing the Christmas Masses to keep yourself – and at least one other to give to a relative, friend or neighbour whom you will be inviting to join you at Mass. The more the merrier! Next Sunday, 24th December, Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent will be celebrated at the usual times, and the Fourth Sunday of Advent, 24th December, and the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord, 25th December, are each individual holydays of obligation, and the obligation cannot be fulfilled by attending Mass and resting only on one of those holydays – God gives his total self to us at Christmas, let us give ourselves totally to him!

'Let Your Light shine before Others' is the theme of our celebration of **Christmas** this year. During this second part of Advent, our focus shifts from the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of time, when 'he will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end', to his First Coming, when 'for us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and was made man', while we celebrate his coming 'in word and in Sacrament to strengthen us and make us holy. Where will be Christ be born in us this Christmas, or do we put him to one side, safely out of our way as we crack on without him? In his Christ, God raises us up to a new home – we are bathed in the sweetness of God's grace! Let us rejoice in that!
