Chrism Mass – 27th March 2024: The Chrism Mass will be celebrated in St Barnabas' Cathedral this Wednesday, 27th March, at 11.30 am. During the Chrism Mass, the priests who are working in our Diocese renew the commitment they made at their Ordination, and the Bishop will bless the Oil of the Sick, which is used in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, and the Oil of Catechumens, which is used in preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism, and consecrate the Oil of Sacred Chrism, which is used at the Sacrament of Baptism, for the Sacrament of Confirmation, at the Sacrament of Holy Orders when Bishops and priests are ordained, and to dedicate altars and churches; the Oils for use in our parish will be received at the beginning of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday. Civic Service – 7th April 2024: On Sunday 7th April, we will welcome the Worshipful the Mayor of the Borough of North East Lincolnshire, Cllr Ian Lindley, and Madam Mayoress, together with Members and officers of the North East Lincolnshire Council and dignitaries from neighbouring local authority areas, for this mayoral year's Civic Service, which will begin at 2.00 pm and to which all are welcome.
