



In the gospel above, Jesus proclaims his divinity thus, "I AM the resurrection and the life". He echoes the divine name given to Moses. Then He promised that anyone who believes in Him will never die. In other words, to believe in Jesus means to be saved from sin and death. People are afraid to die because they are not sure what happens next. Worse, they are worried they might go to hell! Others are afraid to die because they are worried about the people they will leave behind. Obviously, the fear of death shows the utter lack of faith in Jesus who is The way, The truth, and The life (John 14:6).

A true follower of Jesus spends their life, not in fear, but in constant awareness of the presence of "I AM" in his life. Thus, they are always full of joy though death accompanies them wherever they go. They are also in constant awareness that every minute of life is a precious gift that should be spent in loving God and loving others. In this way, every minute of their life is just a preparation to that moment towards – their own resurrection.

Like Martha in our gospel, let us believe and proclaim our faith that Jesus is the Christ who will give eternal life.




Immingham Churches Together Lenten Lunches
