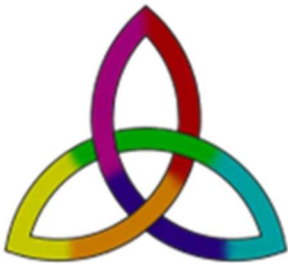
Please wear a mask provided if you are recovering from colds and flu.
